Last Week

While displaced from the gym, students created designs on fabric squares using a technique called stippling over paper shapes. These squares (shown above) are being pieced together into segments which will be joined to the Children's Cloth of Many Colors, a project of Communities of Peace. The segments will be on display very soon.



Meanwhile, the squares have been reproduced on a mug. Mugs can be ordered at a cost of \$15 each. Order forms for the mugs are located by the daily check-out.

A portion of the profits from the mug sales will go to Operation Military Kids, an initiative that works with 4H clubs to provide support for children impacted by military deployment.
