## Redeemer Renaissance After-School Program to be recognized by

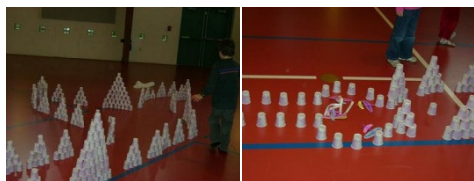
### Lutheran Church of the Redeemer
